

## **AFIIM – ISRA – SFR**

Criteria and condition for the evaluation and prioritization of grant applications:

1. The grant will enable to acquire expertise not available in Israel
2. The applicant should describe the potential academic or clinical benefit of his training to his hospital setting or to Israel
3. The applicant will practice in Israel at least for a year after his return
4. The grant will be given preferably to radiologists who practice in public institutions (public hospitals or clinics serving the community)
5. The professional background of the applicant should be sufficient to reach the intended goal
6. The duration of the training should be sufficient to reach the intended goal
7. A joint clinical or research project agreed by the applicant and the provider of the training is recommended

The candidates should write a letter of application (in English) addressing the above issues (or part of them).

The applicant should mention the required duration and timing of the application.

A personal CV should be included.

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
